Dear Secretary Reagan:

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 19-125(D), the Attorney General is vested with the duty to approve a descriptive title containing a summary of the principal provisions of each ballot measure and a brief phrase stating the essential change in the existing law should the measure be approved by the voters.

On August 29, this Office sent you a letter approving ballot language. After discussions between our offices today, we have determined to modify some of the language for Proposition 306. This letter is to notify you that the Attorney General has approved the enclosed language pursuant to his statutory duties.
