PROPOSITION 306

REFERRED TO THE PEOPLE BY THE LEGISLATURE RELATING TO RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF CAMPAIGN FUNDS BY PUBLICLY FUNDED CANDIDATES AND TO CLEAN ELECTIONS COMMISSION RULEMAKING

OFFICIAL TITLE

AMENDING SECTIONS 16-948 AND 16-956, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE CITIZENS CLEAN ELECTIONS ACT.

DESCRIPTIVE TITLE

THE LAW WOULD PROHIBIT CANDIDATES WHO FINANCE THEIR POLITICAL CAMPAIGNS WITH PUBLIC FUNDING FROM THE CITIZENS CLEAN ELECTIONS COMMISSION FROM TRANSFERRING ANY CAMPAIGN FUNDS TO A POLITICAL PARTY OR PRIVATE TAX-EXEMPT ORGANIZATION THAT ATTEMPTS TO INFLUENCE ELECTIONS AND SUBJECTS THE COMMISSION’S RULEMAKING PROCEDURES TO REGULATORY OVERSIGHT.

A “YES” vote will prohibit statewide and legislative candidates who receive public funding to finance their political campaigns from transferring campaign funds to a political party or a private tax-exempt organization that attempts to influence elections, and will subject the Citizens Clean Elections Commission’s rulemaking procedures to the regulatory oversight that applies to other state agencies by repealing the Commission’s exemption from the Administrative Procedures Act. A “NO” vote will allow the Citizens Clean Elections Commission to determine whether publicly-funded candidates are permitted to transfer their campaign funds to political parties or private tax-exempt organizations that influence candidate elections, and will leave current law unchanged regarding administrative oversight of the Commission’s rulemaking.
